NOTICE OF CLAIMS FILING PROCEDURE

TO ALL CREDITORS AND OTHER INTERESTED PERSONS OF INDEPENDENT TRUST CORPORATION a/k/a INTRUST:

NOTICE is given that on April 14, 2000, the Commissioner of Banks and Real Estate for the State of Illinois ("Commissioner"), through the Attorney General, filed a complaint for dissolution and the winding up of the affairs of Independent Trust Corporation a/k/a Intrust ("Intrust") in the Circuit Court of Cook County, Illinois, Chancery Division located in Chicago, Illinois ("Court"), cause no. 00CH05905. Notice is further given that PricewaterhouseCoopers LLP has been appointed as receiver ("Receiver") for Intrust.

NOTICE is also given that the Court has entered an Order establishing a claims filing procedure for Intrust. Any creditor, or other person asserting any claim of any character against Intrust must present the claim by sending a written claim to the Receiver of Intrust at the following address: Intrust Claims Process, P. O. Box 81770, Chicago, Illinois 60681-1770. All claims must be received by the Receiver at this address on or before **JULY 9, 2001**. All claims must be in writing, sworn and submitted in the form approved by the Court. All claims must be mailed to the Receiver at the address above, and should not be sent to the Clerk or the Court. Account holders of Intrust are not required to file claims to recover trust accounts and trust assets.

The Court has approved a form of proof of claim and written instructions concerning filing of claims. The form of proof of claim, written instructions for filing claims, and the Order establishing the procedure are available and have been published on the Intrust website at www.intrust.com. If any person does not have access to the Intrust website, and such person desires to make a claim against Intrust, such person should make a written request to the Receiver at the address above for a copy of the claim form and instructions.
